EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE RULES

Minors (under age 18) are always required to sign waivers for non-sport and sport activities.

Non-sports oriented RSO/RCOs: Excess Accident Medical Ins. and Participant Waivers are required for all participants of any sporting event in which they participate; see list below. (Example: Chess Club members play in a basketball game.)
